



SCHOOL-BASED TELEHEALTH SERVICES

To Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

South Ripley School Corporation is offering school-based telehealth services through Margaret Mary Health. Medical care may be provided for your child when they become ill during school hours. The school-based telehealth program allows your child the opportunity to be seen by an MMH pediatrician without having to leave school. An enrollment packet and consent must be completed and signed by you before any services are rendered. If your child needs medical care, you do not have to be present for your child to be seen. However, the school nurse will call you and ask for permission prior to initiating the telehealth visit. We ask you review this packet and complete it if you are interested in having your child participate at any time during the school year.

DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES

- Diagnosis and treatment for minor injuries or acute illnesses, such as strep throat, ear infections, rashes, pink eye, influenza
- Instant strep, urine and influenza testing if applicable and ordered by the medical provider
