

SOUTH RIPLEY BOARD OF SCHOOL TRUSTEES

September 9, 2019
Versailles, Indiana

President Tim Taylor called the special session of the South Ripley Board of School Trustees to order at 6:10 PM on Monday, September 9, 2019. Board members present were: Jeff Cornett, Carol Holzer, Danielle McGee, Andy Miller, Lori Samples, and Tim Taylor. Vice-President Randy McIntosh was unable to attend the special session, but arrived in time for the executive session that followed. Superintendent Robert Moorhead was present.

Superintendent Moorhead recommended approval of the agenda as presented. Motion was made to approve by Danielle McGee, seconded by Carol Holzer, vote 6-0.

Under personnel, Superintendent Moorhead recommended approval of Mrs. Gail Snyder to fill the ECA Treasurer position effective September 9, 2019. Mrs. Snyder would work an 8-hour day and retain her previous duties as Bookstore Manager. This would define the ECA Treasurer position as an 8-hour, 205 day position. Due to Mrs. Snyder's experience as the Junior High Secretary, and retaining the bookstore duties, she would be placed at the experienced rate as defined for the ECA Treasurer. This is considered a transfer and does not affect benefits eligibility. Motion was made to approve by Lori Samples, seconded by Danielle McGee, vote 6-0.

Superintendent Moorhead recommended approval of Mrs. Sandy Meyer in the position of Junior High Secretary, effective September 9, 2019. Mrs. Meyer would work the 8-hour daily schedule for the 200 day school year, and be placed at Year 3 of the Junior High Secretary defined rate. Mrs. Meyer has regularly filled in at the Junior High office, and this rate reflects her experience in the office as well as her years in the Junior High School in general. This is considered a transfer and does not affect benefits eligibility. Motion was made to approve by Danielle McGee, seconded by Lori Samples, vote 6-0.

Superintendent Moorhead recommended the employment of Mrs. Peggy Mix to fill the vacant English Teacher position at SRHS for the remaining days of the first semester of the 2019-2020 school year, effective

September 9, 2019. Mrs. Mix is a retired English teacher, and it is recommended she be placed at Masters Level Z for her daily rate. Since this is a temporary assignment, this position would be paid a daily rate for each day worked and is not eligible for benefits. This has been discussed with the SRCTA President since this is a waiver of the placement language in the Master Agreement. Motion was made to approve by Andy Miller, seconded by Danielle McGee, vote 6-0.

Superintendent Moorhead recommended the employment of Ms. Becky Eaton as a long-term substitute in the vacant Special Education Teacher position until a teacher candidate is found. It is recommended that Ms. Eaton be paid her daily rate for the days she works in this position, waiving the practice of paying the first fifteen days as sub pay rate. Ms. Eaton has a life license to teach in special education. Motion was made to approve by Lori Samples, seconded by Andy Miller, vote 6-0.


Superintendent Moorhead recommended the employment of Ms. Elizabeth Forwalt to fill the ED Special Education Aide position at SRJHS/SRHS for the 2019-2020 school year, effective September 9, 2019. This is a 7-hour per school day position, and is eligible for benefits effective October 1, 2019. This vacancy was created by the resignation of Ms. Trista Poman. Motion was made to approve by Danielle McGee, seconded by Lori Samples, vote 6-0.

Superintendent Moorhead recommended Second Reading and approval of the Teacher Appreciation Grant policy as submitted. Motion was made to approve by Jeff Cornett, seconded by Carol Holzer, vote 6-0.


Motion was made to adjourn by Danielle McGee, seconded by Andy Miller, vote 6-0.




